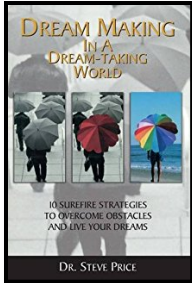


# 2018 Summer Reading Flyer!

## 6-8<sup>th</sup> Grades: 2 Books



All 6-8<sup>th</sup> grade students will read Dream Making in a Dream-Taking World by Dr. Steve Price, connecting to the theme of the new school year, Dream Big. This text identifies 10 key strategies to help individuals take initiative, overcome obstacles, and fulfill their dreams. This book can be found on Amazon.com and other online retailers.

Students must also complete the accompanying packet, which will be made available under the Forms section of the school website.

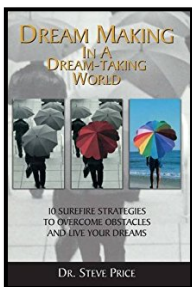

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## 9-12<sup>th</sup> Grades: 2-3 Books

In addition, 9-10<sup>th</sup> grade students will read one English novel and 11-12<sup>th</sup> grade students will read two English novels, as indicated in the chart to the left. Students must then complete the corresponding literary analysis packet for each novel, found under the Forms section of the school website.

In total, freshmen and sophomores will have read two summer reading books, and juniors and seniors will have read three summer reading books by the time school begins in August.
